As a Health Scholar, you'll gain firsthand experience in a clinical setting, impact patients' lives and become an integral part of the patient care team. This unique program allows you to assist with basic care for patients alongside nurses, doctors and other clinicians, preparing you for your career in health care.





PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- At least 18 years old
- Accepted to, enrolled in or graduated from an accredited college or university
- Attend at least one 4-hour shift per week

ROTATIONS

- Health Scholars rotate through many clinical departments, which vary by site.
- As students' skills advance, they may rotate by tier into specialty areas; a few sites have specialty administrative rotations.
- Students complete 280 hours to graduate from the program.





APPLICATION PROCESS

- Complete an application at copehealthscholars.org and pay the application fee
- 2. If selected, attend an in-person interview
- 3. Complete a background check and health screening
- 4. Pay tuition and attend 3-day training
